Why we take off our shoes?

"Do not come any closer," God said. "Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground." Exodus 3:6 Beyth-'el(Bethel) is described as the "House of God and the gate of heaven"(Genesis 28:16-19 The Father had this place constructed by Solomon, which was called by the name that he gave and said in Exodus 25:8, that when my people come to this place, I will dwell there with them. Because of his awesome presence in his house, we reverence it the same way in which Moses reverenced it, by taking off our shoes.

Why do we pray facing the East?

The first person we have recorded in the Bible to pray three times a day: morning, afternoon and evening was David who was an expert in getting his prayers answered. He must of prayed on His knees because David taught that prayers should be done on the knees to show reverence or respect to the Father; helping our prayers to be answered according to Ps.95:6: David also prayed toward the temple according to Ps.5:7 because the help of Yehowah (Lord) came from the East of the temple or sanctuary

Why do we wear white?

The bride of Christ was granted the privilege of clothing herself in fine linen that is bright and pure. Just as a bride wears a white gown as a symbol of her purity, so the bride of Christ receives fine linen attire. We wear white linen because not only does it please God, it is a holy garment and is the righteousness of the saints. (2 Chronicles 5:12; Revelations 15:6; Revelations 19:8,14

Why do women cover their heads?

In the NEW TESTAMENT, Apostle Paul said "every woman who prays or prophesies should have her head covered. If her head is not covered, she brings shame to her head. Then she is the same as a woman who has her head shaved. 6 If a woman does not cover her head, it is the same as cutting off all her hair. But it is shameful for a woman to cut off her hair or to shave her head. So she should cover her head.

Why do we bow our knees when we call on the name of Christ?

Philippians' 2: 10-11 said that when speaking his HOLY name, every knee should bow and that every tongue should confess that Christ is Lord. Out of reverence and complete respect for his name, whenever we call on it, we bow our knee in honor of it.

Why do we worship on Saturday and not Sunday?

God is worthy to be worshiped every day. The real question is what day did God set aside as HIS holy day? Isaiah said ""Keep the Sabbath day holy. Don't pursue your own interests on that day, but enjoy the Sabbath and speak of it with delight as the LORD's holy day. If we have a desire to enter into God's rest, we must enter into his DAY of rest (Hebrews 4:4,9-10) said that we start this process by entering into HIs Day of Rest. The Sabbath Day is so special to the Father, that the seventh day Sabbath will be kept in the new heavens and the new earth. (Isaiah 66:20-23)
